Our structured and supportive approach allows patients to reduce their symptoms, regain their confidence and achieve greater levels of functioning.

Aurora offers two levels of mental health outpatient care:

- Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP)
- Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP)



Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP)

Aurora's Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP), or more commonly referred to as a day program, is a comprehensive, short-term outpatient program that provides support and treatment for adults facing emotional or mental difficulties. Our program offers all of the programming features of inpatient care, but without the overnight hospital stay and is, therefore, more affordable and more convenient for the patient. The structured format provides physician oversight, plus therapeutic groups and activities.

Mental Health Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP)



Our Intensive Outpatient group therapy programs are designed for individuals seeking tools and principles of recovery whether as a step down from an inpatient or partial hospitalization setting, or simply someone needing treatment and support. Treatment providers use a variety of approaches to address the unique needs of their patients. Methodologies used are evidence-based and have shown high success rates in decreasing symptoms and increasing functioning of participants. Aurora offers these programs at various times and days, which focus on education and coping skills that teach each

patient healthy ways of managing their symptoms.

One of the benefits of attending an IOP program is that you can receive intensive therapy, yet are still be able to maintain your daily schedule. All programs meet three days a week for a three-hour session. And, we offer a variety of times and dates for our classes. We also offer complimentary transportation to certain areas as well as complimentary snacks.
