

Aurora Driving Under the Influence (DUI) Screening, Education, and Treatment

Aurora Behavioral Health System's (ABHS) Outpatient services offers DUI screening, education, and treatment services in a healthy therapeutic environment.

The program is designed to address individuals and community members' need of seeking comprehensive screening and intervention services to develop effective self-regulation skills and promote a healthy life style.

All clients will have diagnostic testing which is conducted in accordance with the Arizona State Statutes, and from there they will be referred accordingly to either our Level II (16 hours) or 72 hour Chemical Dependency program, or outside agencies that may provide 20, 54 and 64 hours DUI programs, The diagnostic tests we use are the SASSI-4 and the MAST.



ABHS's DUI Curriculum and Education Focus will Consist of the Following:

- Physiological and Social Effects, Risks and Consequences of the Use of Alcohol
- Alcohol Consumption and its Effect on Brain and Decision Making Process
- Legal Consequences of the Use of Alcohol
- Symptoms of Alcohol use Disorder and the Addiction Cycle/Pattern
- Learning how to Identify Triggers and Establishing Solid Relapse Prevention Skills
- Cultivating accountability and Healthy Support System to Enhance Meaningful Personal, Inter-personal, and Social Life



What to Expect from ABHS DUI Education and Treatment Services

All clients will take a Pre and Post-test which will allow them to gauge their own progress. Education and treatment participation will follow strict attendance to maintain the standard of the services provided at ABHS.

Clients will have progress notes given to their referring agency or court on a pre-arranged time table. In addition, clients will receive certification upon successful completion of the DUI education or treatment program. All groups will be facilitated by state licensed clinicians.
